TRIP FEE: The fee for this 3-day optional trip is \$385 which includes roundtrip transportation, hotel accommodations, all meals, admission fees, and gratuities. Transportation is provided by comfortable air-conditioned chartered buses equipped with a bathroom and DVD for movie viewing.

ELIGIBLE CAMPERS: Campers must be entering 6th grade (or higher) in September and must have proof of citizenship (a valid passport or an original birth certificate for a USA citizen born in the United States).

TRIP DATES: This 3-day trip is scheduled on July 28, July 29, and July 30, 2010.

TRIP AGREEMENT: We ask parents to read and explain to their camper the contents of the *Canada Trip Agreement* which is accessible on-line from the "Camp Forms" webpage. Cayuga's Trip Director will review this Agreement, in addition to trip policies & safety procedures, with your camper during an orientation meeting prior to the trip. Campers will be asked at camp to sign a copy of the *Canada Trip Agreement* acknowledging their understanding of its content.

TRIP REFUND: A full refund will be provided up until June 1st. After June 1st, a full refund will be provided (in the order cancellations are received) if the child's reservation can be replaced with a camper on Cayuga's official waiting list. All refunds will be mailed after the camp season but before September 30th.

TRIP ITINERARY:

DAY 1

- ☉ Deluxe air-conditioned bus with restroom and DVD departs from Cayuga after an early breakfast.
- ☉ Lunch at the **Hard Rock Café** at Niagara Falls.
- ☉ View the Magnificent Niagara Falls from **Observation Tower at Prospect Point**. You'll ride the glass-walled elevator which rises above the Falls and descends to the base of the gorge for two different breathtaking perspectives of the Falls.
- ☉ Tour the **Cave of the Winds** where you'll hear and feel the water thunder on the rocks while the water and cool mist rushes all around you. (Waterproof clothing is provided.)
- ☉ Experience the magic and power of the Falls when you board the world famous **Maid of the Mist** and ride to the basin of the Falls. It's the ride of a lifetime!
- ☉ Dinner meal served in the scenic Niagara Falls area.
- ☉ Bus departs Niagara Falls.
- ☉ Overnight hotel accommodations in Toronto, Canada.

DAY 2

- ☉ Bus departs hotel immediately after breakfast meal.
- ☉ Arrive at **Canada's Wonderland**, Canada's premier theme park, for an action-packed day from morning till night.
