VISITATION INFORMATION

There is no official Visiting Day, however parents are welcome to visit their child if they so desire. This option is available to all parents, except those who have campers enrolled in a 2-week session. Visitation is not permitted for 2-weekers.

Parents have the flexibility to visit on any day. If you plan to visit your child, call the camp office. Let us know the date you would like to visit and the time you plan to arrive. Visitations are permitted any time after 11:00am.

Since special visitations can adversely affect other campers, parents are asked to keep a low profile. That is, visitors must remain at the office until their camper is escorted from his/her activity. Parents are not permitted to enter the cabin area or roam around camp.

Upon your arrival, report to the office and we will sign-out your child. Campers must return to camp before 4:00pm. Upon your return, report to the office to sign-in your camper.
