- * We are encouraging Lohikan's staff to apply at Camp Cayuga for summer employment next season, and have already received several inquiries.
- * Every former Camp Lohikan camper attending Cayuga for the first time will be covered by Camp Cayuga's First-Time Camper Guarantee.
- * We will honor each camper's years at Camp Lohikan when presenting our annual camper awards. For example, a camper who would have earned a five-year award will receive Camp Cayuga's five-year award. (If Lohikan's traditional five-year jacket is available, we will proudly recognize and support that milestone as well.)

Campers will find many of the activities and traditions they loved at Lohikan, along with new opportunities unique to Camp Cayuga. Most importantly, your child will find a caring community where every camper is welcomed, valued, and included from the very first day.
